17-041 CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S REPORT:

041.1 Sockeye Spawning (8.1)

Council noted it was pleasing to see such a significant increase in numbers of sockeye salmon. It was thought that this could be contributing to the increased trout productivity in Lake Benmore. It was felt it would be good to establish a monitoring programme to understand more about this situation. It could serve as an index of aquatic health and good water quality. It was **AGREED** that staff bring a monitoring proposal to the October Council meeting for Council's consideration.

041.2 Ahuriri River Angler Satisfaction Survey 2016 (8.2)

In light of the information contained in the report Council did not see a need to nominate the Ahuriri River as a backcountry fishery. Council found it pleasing that the report showed angler satisfaction is high and were interested to see 50% of anglers fishing the Ahuriri River were Non-Resident anglers.

041.4 Budget Policy for National Policy (8.4)

Provided for Council consideration was a report received from NZ Council bringing forward recommendations for National Policy relating to financial management, recording, and reporting. In particular it relates to policies under 2.7 National Budget Policy in existing national policy.

Chief Executive noted that section 2.7.6 stated that "all expenditure will need to be approved as part of the budget round." This would mean that Non-Resident Licence income and habitat fund would require 'approval' to spend. He felt this should read 'notified' and not 'approval'.

- Hinds Drain work undertaken has been encouraging with an adult trout being caught during monitoring. M Webb noted the work has created deep pool habitat that was not previously present.
- RDR Consents and concerns at further delays. Fish and Game will be formally writing to Environment Canterbury raising concerns about the basis for the further delay. We will be requesting information on how non-compliance by RDR will be addressed and who was consulted on the proposal to have further delays as Fish and Game as a statutory body were not consulted.
- Spawning Surveys it was confirmed that aerial counts are the most accurate form of this information.
